




This permanent orienteering course gives an introduction to beginners of the sport and challenges those of intermediate ability.

The aim is to go from the start and find the markers attached to wooden posts in the order they are laid out on the map, and then copy the 2 letter code, written on the marker, into the boxes provided.

Three courses are given: Course 1 is designed for absolute beginners and wheelchair competitors, and there is increasing difficulty with Courses 2 and 3. However, it is possible to visit the markers in any order.

Once you have found all the markers, you can detach the completed control card and send an A4 SAE to: OUOC Secretary, c/o OU Sports Federation, University Sports Complex, Iffley Road, Oxford OX4 1EQ, with your name, and you will receive a certificate.

Please respect other visitors and the by-laws of the University Parks, and note that there is a closing time.

Course 1 - 1.9km, 5m climb
 △ Start - car park, northern edge
 1. Fence corner
 2. Bench, south side
 3. Information Board, beneath
 4. Vegetation boundary corner
 5. Bench, north side
 6. Path junction, south side
 7. Bench, south side
 8. Distinctive Tree, south side

Course 2 - 1.9km, 20m climb
 △ Start - car park, northern edge
 9. Fence, southern corner
 10. Distinctive tree, south-west side
 11. Clearing, south-east edge
 12. Flower bed, eastern end
 13. Hill, north-east side
 14. Where there once was a tree...
 15. Depression

Course 3 - 2.2km, 15m climb
 △ Start - car park, northern edge
 16. Southern distinctive tree, S side
 17. Bench, north-east side
 18. Path
 19. Distinctive tree, west side
 20. Middle bench, north-west side
 21. Between thickets
 22. Thicket, north-east tip
 23. Gully, west end
 24. Distinctive tree, inside

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
