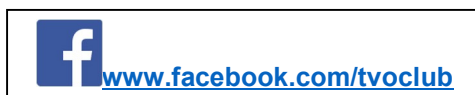

| Terrain: | Classic Chiltern undulating slopes covered in mature beech or mixed deciduous and conifer. Brushings and undergrowth are limited. |

Eligibility conditions to be British Champion are set out in section 2.1 of Competition Rule E UKOL: In order to score UKOL points, you must run the long course for your age class (or your age class if the class does not offer separate Long and Short classes) |

| Fees: | Reduce fee entries (CD1): Seniors £18.00, Juniors & Students £8.00. Final entries (CD2): Seniors £20.00, Juniors & Students £9.00. SI dibber hire: (Seniors and Juniors): £2.00 per dibber |
| SI Air: | The event will have SI Air enabled. If you do not have a SIAC card you can hire one from us for £2. If you have an SI card (i.e. non-Air) you are welcome to use it if you wish. Your time, however, will be longer as a result. Our firm advice, therefore, is to hire a SIAC card for the event. |
| Start Times etc.: | SI dibber Collection: 18:00-19:30hrs Starts: 18:45-20:00hrs Courses close: 22:00hrs. Prize giving: 21:30hrs (approx.) The narrow start window for this event makes providing split start times difficult. We will try to meet such requests as best we can. |
