3) Juniors Update (Paul Taylor)

This has been a successful junior series. Eight events were included during the series this year. There were a number of worthy age class winners. Paul will get some mementos and certificates to issue to the winners.



It was slightly unfortunate that the last junior league event was the same weekend as the Club Championships (Kingswood and then Black Park). So a number of juniors "picked" one event or the other to enter, which had the effect of reducing the junior attendance at both events.

A successful year on other fronts too. TVOC were 2nd in July's Yvette Baker trophy. Various other relays were entered successfully, too, through the year.

We are getting younger juniors involved now, so we hope to keep the success and momentum going. We also hope to continue with more junior coaching.

It was agreed that it was a very successful year for the juniors.

The meeting formally thanked Paul, Joel and Nathan Taylor for their incredible efforts and success achieved for our juniors during the year.

In summary:

- The club's finances continue to be very sound, with no concerns
- We are actively NOT trying to generate a surplus from the Saturday Series of events
- We continue to have sufficient cash in the bank to enable us to organise large events and deal with emergency or unexpected expenditure
- Our OCAD license needs renewing in June 2024
- We now have an overall forward budget that covers three financial years (2023/24, 2024/25 and 2025/26).
- On average, the club needs to generate an annual event surplus of about £4,500 to cover the club's fixed costs
- b) Discussion about budgeting and entry fee pricing for events (John Dalton)
 A discussion has been had outside the meeting about the setting of event entry fees. Specifically, the debate has been about whether Level C and Level B event Organisers need to produce a budget for each of the events they organise in order to set entry fees to generate an appropriate surplus for their events.

Currently, some Organisers do produce a budget, and some do not.



A discussion was had in the meeting about the two options the club has in the future for setting event entry fees at Level C and Level B events:

- Option 1. Organiser produces a budget for their event, setting entry fees appropriately so that their event produces an acceptable surplus for the club's needs
- Option 2. The CLUB (led by the Treasurer) establishes a standard set of fees that will be used for all TVOC events throughout the financial year.
 - o This means that the Organiser does not need to produce a budget.
 - This also means that the club (led by the Treasurer) needs to understand the likely costs and revenues for events through the whole financial year

It was **AGREED** that Option 2 was to be accepted. In the future, TVOC will establish what entry fees will be for Level B and Level C events in advance of each financial year.

ACTION: John Dalton will put a table together of proposed standard entry fees for Level B and Level C events that can be reviewed by the Treasurer, and discussed at the next meeting.

c) Proposed TVOC Grants and Awards Policy
 A draft of the proposed Policy was discussed at a previous meeting.

ACTION: Chris Poole would update the Policy wording based on the feedback provided before final agreement of the policy at the next meeting.

A brief discussion was had about whether the club's policy on expenses needs changing in any way. It was **AGREED** that the current policy of refunding legitimate, reasonable expenses that had actually been incurred by club members when mapping, planning or organising did not need to be changed.
