• Plenty of parking there. It was explored for the JK Relay in 2019, but wasn't really suitable. Might be OK for a Level C event. This is a very big area.

• They approached us a while ago. Concerns that the woodlands are rather feature-less.

#### **Christmas Common**

• Parking is a problem for a larger event. Could be used for a Saturday Series event. We have used Zelda's field before for parking. But this is not great in the wet.

It was agreed that finding adequate car parking is a fundamental issue for the future.



## 2024

a) **CONFIRMED**: Chiltern Challenge, Penn Wood, Common Wood and Penn Estate. (March 24th 2024, National/Level B.)

Map:



The 3 areas (Penn Wood/Common Wood/ Penn Estate) have been re-maped.

Alun Jones reported that all is going well. Alun is expecting up to 500 people to attend. Please note Alun's request in e-News for all entrants to be efficient on car parking use.

b) **CONFIRMED**: Regional Event, Hodgemoor. (Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> April 2024, Regional/Level C and YBT qualifying round.)

#### Map:

Mark Thompson) will update.

#### Paul Taylor provided an update:

Permissions have been received. Entries are now open via SIEntries. Team Leaders have been sent details relating to the requirements for their teams (including the code for free entries for volunteers).

All control sites have been checked and agreed between Planner and Controller.

An initial article has been written and published in e-News to let club members know about the event.

c) **CONFIRMED** Urban Event, Thame (Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2024, Regional/Level C.)

#### **ACTIONS:**

Nev still to find officials.

#### Map:

Bob has been in touch with Mike Shires. Bob has updated the map to ISSprOM 2019-2 at 1:4000 scale. Bob and Mike will update the map between them and possibly extend slightly south and east.

This will not be a UKUL event.

### Neville reported.

We still need to find the necessary officials. The map does need an update, and could perhaps be extended. A double-sided map would enable the map to be fitted on an A3 page. Mike Shires / Bob Beresford will ensure the map is updated.

**ACTION**: Nev will register the event for the South of England Urban League.

d) **PROPOSED**: Instead of Kingswood Saturday Series, Didcot Urban tbc., (Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> October 2024), Regional/Level C

It has been proposed that the Saturday Series planned for Kingswood on Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> be switched to a Level C event on Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> October, at Didcot.

This is because there is very little other orienteering on that weekend other than the CompassSport Cup Final in Lancashire.

After extensive discussion about an acceptable forest or urban location. Wendover was mentioned, but this has been used frequently recently. Didcot was suggested as an Urban event.

A concern was expressed that OUOC might need some TVOC help for the following weekend. Are the events too close together? It was also noted that we have another urban event in September, and an event in December. Another concern was that a Didcot Urban might interfere with numbers for the Oxford City Race the following week.

If Didcot is confirmed, Paul Eaton might be prepared to update the map.

No final decision was made in the meeting. If we run an urban event Didcot on Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> October, parking could be on-street. If the Didcot event is confirmed, we will NOT continue with the October Saturday Series event on the 12<sup>th</sup> October.



#### ACTIONS:

Key is to confirm parking before confirming event.

**Map:** Will need updating for any future forestry work before 2025. Bob stated that further felling and thinning has taken place since his previous report.

Car parking still needs to be confirmed.

Key is to identify an Organiser. Critical is to confirm car parking for this event. Bob highlighted that the map has already had a lot of time spent on it remapping. There has now been further forestry work. The only valid option for car parking seems to be to re-approach the farmer for use of his field at the top.

Roger T has offered to plan this event.

Map: Bob and Pattie to do the mapping.

Roger Thetford will plan. Roger and Bob are in contact about the best areas to map. Town Council have already granted permission. Still need an Organiser.
